Subject to the *Fire Prevention and Open Burning Bylaw* for the Town of Shelburne, holders of a *Permit to Burn* may still be liable for damages caused as a result of improper burning. Be advised that it is the permit holder's responsibility to check provincial burning notices prior to any burning.

CONDITIONS:

1. Sufficient help must be engaged and care taken to prevent the fire from spreading and the fire must be watched until it is completely extinguished.
2. Brush must be divided into piles.
3. No burning of items other than garden and yard waste.

NOTICE:

1. The permit holder may be required to pay all expenses incurred in controlling or extinguishing any fire which may get beyond control or be in danger of doing so or extend to the lands of others.
2. A Fire Permit may be cancelled or suspended at any time by the Fire Chief and upon receiving notice of such a cancellation or suspension, the permit holder shall extinguish any fire started under the permit.
3. Any person failing to comply with the terms and conditions contained on a permit to burn or during a suspension / cancellation of said permit, is guilty of an offence under the *Fire Prevention and Open Burning Bylaw*.
4. This permit is subject to the daily Fire Index Report from the NS Department of Lands and Forestry relating to open air burning times and/or restrictions.
