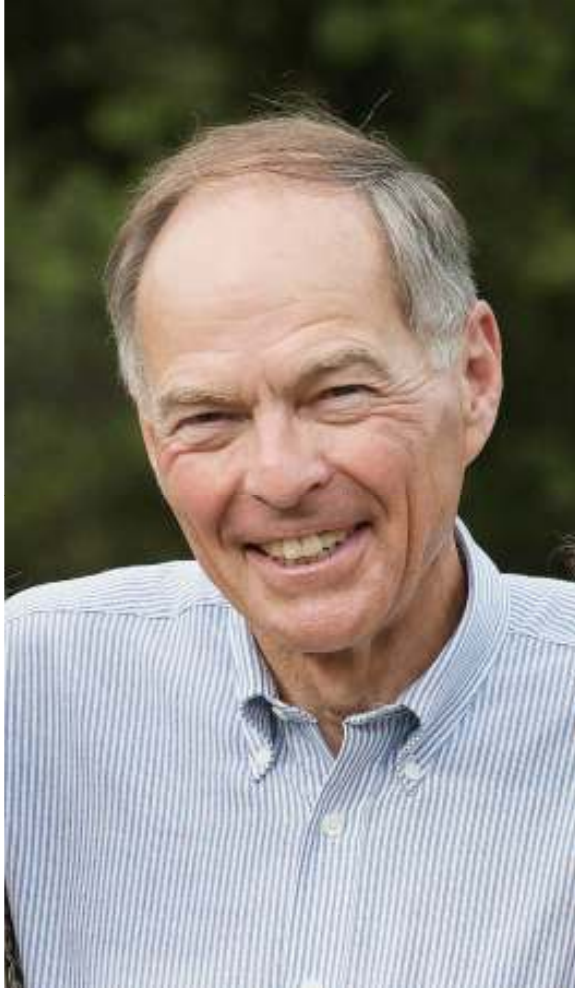


Chris Sharpe
